Ericksonian Therapy has established as an effective and broadly applicable approach around the world. Clinical hypnosis is found to be particularly effective for common disorders such as anxiety, pain, habits and trauma. The Ericksonian Model is focused and brief, an approach which is especially useful in settings in which there is a high demand for service.

Clinicians are able to incorporate Ericksonian techniques into their already existing skills, augmenting the manner in which clients are served. It is compatible other approaches (e.g., with many Cognitive Behavioural Therapy, Solution-Focused Therapy, Couple Therapy).

Learning clinical hypnosis expands therapeutic possibilities for the therapist.

#### WHO SHOULD ATTEND?
